



Mary Dunaj

August 30, 1914 - May 28, 2007

Mrs. Mary (Balut) Dunaj, 92, a former longtime resident of Adams, died late Monday evening at Northampton Rehabilitation and Nursing Center in Northampton, MA.

She was born in Windber, Pennsylvania on August 30, 1914, a daughter of the late Anthony and Katherine (Leja) Balut. She came to Adams as a child with her family, and attended Adams schools. She lived in Adams until moving to Belchertown in 2005, and then to Northampton last year.

Mrs. Dunaj worked at the former Wall Streeter Shoe Co. in North Adams for many years, until the mill closed. She then worked at the former Waverly Fabrics in Adams until retiring in 1986.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and was a member of the St. Stanislaus Rosary Sodality.

Her husband, Joseph C. Dunaj, whom she married on May 29, 1954, died on January 17, 1973.

She is survived by 2 nephews - John Sadlo of Windsor, MA and Russell Balut of Belchertown, MA;

A Grandniece - Jennie DiSelice of Woburn, MA;

A Grandnephew - Timothy Balut of Belchertown, MA ; and several cousins.

She was predeceased by a sister, Helen Sadlo, on Feb. 12, 2004; and by 2 brothers, August Balut on October 10, 1986, and William Balut on August 12, 1989.
