November 6, 1908 - October 31, 2010

Mrs. Mary Isabelle (Librizzi) Fasce, formerly of 7 Park St. Adams, died Sunday morning, October 31, 2010, at Berkshire Place in Pittsfield, in her 102nd year.

She was born in Pittsfield on November 6, 1908, daughter of the late Charles and Anna (Monteleone) Librizzi. She attended Pittsfield schools, and graduated from Pittsfield High School with the Class of 1927.

Mrs. Fasce worked in the advertising department of Crane & Co. in Dalton for 43 years, until retiring in 1970.

She had been a communicant of the former Parish of Notre Dame & St. Thomas Aquinas, Adams, and was a member of the St. St. Thomas Rosary Sodality.

Her husband, Raymond E. Fasce, whom she married on October 13, 1952, died on January 1, 1997.
