Mrs. Mary S. (Dunaj) Gajda, 91, of Adams, died Friday afternoon, February 3, 2023 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield. She was born in Adams on August 26, 1931, a daughter of the late Ignatius and Mary (Wlodyka) Dunaj. She returned with her parents to Poland at age 4, and after nine months, with World War II brewing in Europe, her family returned to Adams.
