Mrs. Mary H. (Brennan) Gaule, 99, of Lanesborough, formerly of Adams, died Sunday afternoon, September 8, 2024 at Hillcrest Commons in Pittsfield. She was born in Chicago, IL on August 8, 1925, daughter of the late Bernard J. and Mary W. (Hughes) Brennan.
