Mrs. Maryrose G. (West) Snyder, 95, of Cedar Park, TX, formerly of East Rd., Adams, died on Friday, April 28, 2017 in Texas.

She was born in North Adams on June 27, 1921, a daughter of Edward and Albina (Soulier) West. She attended schools in North Adams and Northampton and graduated from Northampton High School.
