



Matthew L. Bellora

July 28, 1942 - February 17, 2008

Matthew Louis Bellora, 65, of 11 Arnold Avenue, Adams, died late Sunday evening, February 17, 2008, at North Adams Regional Hospital.

He was born in Pittsfield on July 28, 1942, a son of the late Corado and Norma (Tezza) Bellora. He attended Pittsfield schools, graduating from Pittsfield High School in 1960.

Mr. Bellora was a Vietnam era veteran, serving with the US Air Force from 1990 until his honorable discharge as an Airman Second Class in 1964.

Mr. Bellora was self-employed as a hair stylist for many years. He established and operated Matthew's Hair Styles on Howland Avenue in Adams in 1975, until moving it to Park St. and renaming it Headquarters. He finally moved to Commercial St. and continued as Headquarters until retiring in 2000. He then spent several years as a sales representative for Haddad Motors in North Adams.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and was a longtime member of the Adams Lions Club.

He enjoyed deep-sea fishing and spending time with family and friends.

He is survived by his wife of 41 years, the former Jean G. Scieniewski, whom he married on August 20, 1966;
