



Matthew F. Mastalerz

January 28, 1923 - March 31, 2007

Mr. Matthew Frank Mastalerz, 84, of 115 Ridgeway Avenue, Pittsfield, died early Saturday morning at his home.

He was born in Pittsfield on January 28, 1923, a son of the late John and Agatha (Szlosek) Mastalerz, and graduated from Pittsfield High School.

He was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the US Army.

Mr. Mastalerz worked for the Power Transformer Division of General Electric Co. in Pittsfield for 40 years, until retiring in 1983.

He was a communicant of Holy Family Church and was a member of American Legion Post 68 in Pittsfield, and the General Electric Quarter Century and Pensioner's Clubs.

He enjoyed fishing and gardening, and especially sharing the fruits of his hobbies with friends and family.

He is survived by his wife, the former Cecilia Wojtaszek, whom he married on October 26, 1957 in St. Stanislaus Kostka Church in Adams;
