



Matthew S. Witek, Sr.

May 15, 1925 - March 31, 2008

Matthew Stanley Witek, Sr., 82, of 60 East St. Adams, died late Monday evening, March 31, 2008, at North Adams Regional Hospital.

He was born in Adams on May 15, 1925, a son of the late Joseph and Mary (Wojnarowska) Witek, and attended Adams schools, including St. Stanislaus Kostka Elementary School.

He was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the US Navy in the Mediterranean Ocean, participating in invasions of North Africa and Sicily.

Mr. Witek worked as an inspector at the Beloit Corp. in Dalton, retiring in 1988 after 33 years of service.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. He enjoyed woodworking and fixing machinery, was an avid hunter and fisherman, and was a fan of the Boston Red Sox and Boston Celtics.

He is survived by 2 sons - Matthew S. Witek, Jr. of Adams, and Butch Witek of Lanesboro;

2 daughters - Carol Witek of Williamstown, and Beverly Maselli of Clarksburg; 13 Grandchildren, 7 great grandchildren, and many nieces, nephews, grandnieces & grandnephews.

His former wife, Alice (Ziembra) Witek Rosenberg, died on October 8, 2003. A son, Robert "Joe" Witek, died April 4, 1999. He was predeceased by 2 brothers, Stanley and Walter Witek, and by 2 sisters, Julia Pralat and Blanche Ciempa.

Noon in St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams.
