Mr. Maxwell N.G. Williamson, 73, of Adams, died Wednesday evening, April 5, 2023 at his home. He was born in Kilmarnock, Scotland on September 6, 1949, a son of the late Alexander and Margaret (Duthie) Williamson. He came to the United States as a child with his family, settling in Lee, MA, and attended Lee High School.

He last worked at the former James River Paper Co. in Adams for several years. Earlier, he worked at the Mountain Mill division of Westfield Paper Co. in Lee for many years and was assistant plant manager when the mill closed.

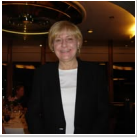
