Mr. Michael E. Nye, 74, of Cheshire, died Sunday afternoon, September 11, 2022 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield. He was born in Adams on April 11, 1948, a son of the late John E. Nye and Alida (Lipka) Nye Gagnon. He attended Adams schools and C.H. McCann Technical High School, North Adams.

He was a Veteran of the Vietnam War, serving with the United States Marine Corps from 1968 until his Honorable Discharge as a Lance Corporal in 1970. Mike worked as a machine operator at General Electric Co. in Pittsfield and Schenectady, NY for 27 years. He then worked in the maintenance department for Hillcrest Educational Centers until retiring in 2010. Mike was a member of Adams Post 160 American Legion and enjoyed fishing and working around his home and property, especially caring for his lawn. He is survived by his wife of 54 years, the former Shirley A. 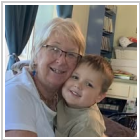
