Mr. Milan Philip Scalise, 83, of 27 Orchard St. Adams, died peacefully early Sunday morning, August 29, 2010, at Williamstown Commons.

He was born in North Adams on November 25, 1926, a son of the late Philip and Carmela (Trimarchi) Scalise. He attended North Adams schools, and had lived in North Adams and Adams his entire life.

He was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the 140th Chemical Warfare Company of the US Army in the European Theater, until his Honorable Discharge in 1946.

Mr. Scalise last worked in the maintenance department of Hoosac Bank in North Adams until his retirement.

His wife, the former Florence Alice Derosia, whom he married on October 26, 1957, died on July 27, 2001.
