Miss Mildred May Smith, 86, of 13 Beech St. Adams, died Saturday morning, November 13, 2004 at North Adams Commons.

She was born in Adams on August 21, 1918, the daughter of the late Norman and Mildred (Williams) Smith, and attended Adams schools, graduating from the former Adams High School.

Miss Smith worked as the Administrative Assistant to the Director of Buildings and Grounds at Williams College in Williamstown for over 30 years, until retiring 20 years ago.

She was an active member of the First Congregational Church of Adams, where she taught Sunday School and was a member and former director of its Choir. She was also a member of the Williams College Retiree's Club.
