Mrs. Monica Esther (Kruzel) Cyrulik, 89, of 4 Columbia St. Adams, died early Friday morning, December 19th, at her home.

She was born in Adams on November 8, 1919, a daughter of the late Matthew and Helen (Meczywor) Kruzel, and attended Adams schools, including St. Stanislaus Elementary School.

Mrs. Cyrulik last worked in the sewing department of the former Waverly Fabrics in Adams for 15 years, until her retirement. Earlier, she had worked at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. in Adams and the former Sprague Electric Co. in North Adams.
