Mrs. Monica M. (Urbanek) Wojcik, 92, of 16 Crandall St. Adams, died Monday morning at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

She was born in Adams on July 28, 1912, a daughter of the late Frank and Veronica (Szetela) Urbanek, and attended Adams schools, graduating from the former Adams High School.

Mrs. Wojcik was primarily a bookkeeper all of her life, working at the former O.W. Gavett Oldsmobile dealership in North Adams, and also for Adams Laundry & Dry Cleaning in Adams.
