



Mrs. Nancy A. Whalen

January 25, 1930 - June 17, 2015

Mrs. Nancy Ann (Rotolo) Whalen, 85, of 2 Kittler Ave., Adams, died on Wednesday, June 17, 2015 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

She was born in North Adams on January 25, 1930, a daughter of the late Vincent and Josephine (Naso) Rotolo. She attended schools in North Adams and graduated from Drury High School.

Mrs. Whalen was a homemaker, staying home to raise her family.

She was a communicant of the Parish of St. John Paul II at Notre Dame des Sept Douleurs Church, and was a longtime communicant of the former St. Thomas Aquinas Church. She was a very active member of the Sons of Italy, North Adams, the Friends of the North Adams Library and the Parish of St. John Paul II Rosary Sodality. Her husband, Edward P. Whalen, whom she married on August 13, 1949, died on December 23, 2006.
