January 14, 1926 - December 25, 2005

Mrs. Natalie Stacia (Maznicki) Wronski, 79, of 44 Fisk Road, Adams, died Sunday, December 25, 2005 at Baystate Medical Center in Springfield, MA. She was born in Adams on January 15, 1926, a daughter of the late Andrew and Anna (Frodyma) Maznicki. She attended Adams schools, and graduated from the former Adams High School.

Mrs. Wronski worked at the former Arnold Print Works in Adams for over 30 years, retiring as personnel manager when the mill ceased operations in the 1980's. Earlier, she had worked briefly at General Electric Co. in Pittsfield. She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. She was a member of the St. Stanislaus Rosary Sodality, the Forest Park Country Club in Adams, and was a member of several local bowling leagues.

She enjoyed golfing, bowling, knitting and sewing, and snowmobiling.

Her husband, Alexander V. Wronski, whom she married on December 27, 1947, died on December 29, 2003.

She is survived by 3 sisters - Joan Maznicki of Adams; May Cwikla of Windsor, CT and Emily Schiessl of Suffield, CT;

1 Brother - Adolf Maznicki of Adams; and several nieces, nephews, grandnieces & grandnephews.

Her son, William Wronski, died August 15, 1980, and a brother, Joseph Maznicki, is deceased.
