Patricia Ann (Gleba-Pikul) Callander, 68, of 17 Pleasant St. Adams, died Friday morning, May 13, 2016, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield. She was born in Adams on June 9, 1947, daughter of the late Zigmund Gleba and Helen (Fryn) Gleba Pikul.
