



## Mrs. Patricia A. Kelley

March 14, 1934 - October 19, 2015

Mrs. Patricia Ann (Jurczak) Kelley, 81, of 3 Daniels Court, Adams, died Monday morning, October 19, 2015, at her home.

She was born in Adams on March 14, 1934, the daughter of the late Albert and Emma (Doyle) Jurczak. She attended Adams schools, and graduated from the former Adams High School with the Class of 1952.

Mrs. Kelley last worked as a paraprofessional for the Adams- Cheshire Regional School District.

She was a communicant of the Parish of St. John Paul II, and the former St. Thomas Aquinas Church, Adams. She was a member of its Rosary Sodality and of the Catholic Daughters of the Americas. She had also been a very active volunteer for the St. Thomas Bazaar for many years.

Her husband, Earl F. Kelley, whom she married on May 1, 1954, died on February 23, 2004.
