May 3, 1934 - June 6, 2012

Mr. Paul John Caron, 78, of 10 Cypress Lane, Pittsfield, died Wednesday morning, June 6, 2012, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on May 3, 1934, a son of the late Eli and Gladys (Bejgrowicz) Caron, and attended Adams schools. He had lived in Florida for several years, and in Pittsfield for the past several years.

Mr. Caron was a Veteran of the Korean Conflict, serving with the US Marine Corps from 1953 until being Honorably Discharged in 1956.

Mr. Caron last worked as a truck driver for Holland Co. in Adams, until retiring in 1993.

He had been a member of the former Notre Dame des Sept Douleurs Parish, Adams, and had been a member of the American Legion and Masonic Temple while living in Florida.

He was a charter member of the Cheshire Rod and Gun Club, and enjoyed hunting, fishing and target shooting.

He is survived by his wife of 57 years, the former Mary A. Baker, whom he married on August 21, 1954;
