Mr. Paul David Cote, 49, of Cheshire, died on Monday, August 20, 2018 at Berkshire Medical Center in North Adams.

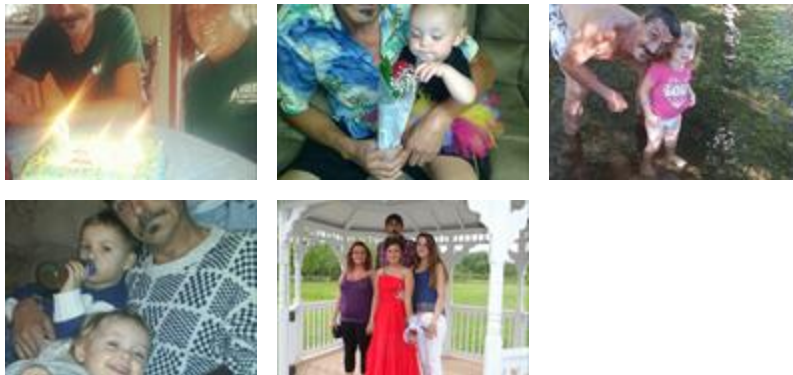
