January 14, 1927 - February 7, 2011

Mr. Paul Arthur Kleiner, 84, of 16 Prospect St. Adams, died Monday morning, February 7, 2011, at Williamstown Commons.

He was born in Adams on January 14, 1927, a son of the late Henry and Henrietta (Wolfrum) Kleiner. He attended Adams schools, and graduated from the former Adams High School, where he was team captain of both the football and baseball teams. He was a veteran of World War II, serving with the United States Navy.

Mr. Kleiner was self-employed as a painter and paperhanger for over 50 years.

He was a member of St. Mark's Episcopal Church, Adams. An avid golfer, he was a member of the Taconic Golf Club in Williamstown for 40 years, and was also a member of the Forest Park Country Club in Adams. He also enjoyed hunting and bowling, and was a member of the Adams Turners.

His wife, the former Rita I. Roemelt, whom he married on October 21, 1950, died on December 23, 2010.

He is survived by many nieces, nephews, grandnieces & grandnephews. The last of his immediate family, he was predeceased by his 7 brothers, Henry, Walter, Gerhardt, Emil, Otto, Alfred and Max Kleiner; and by his 2 sisters, Ella Genesi and Esther Herzog.
