Mrs. Pauline Helen (Koperniak) Saharczewski, 88, of 9 Turners Avenue, Adams,

died Monday evening, May 19, 2008, at North Adams Regional Hospital.

She was born in Adams on February 14, 1920, a daughter of the late Ludwik and Helena (Bukowska) Koperniak, and attended St. Stanislaus Elementary School in Adams.

Mrs. Saharczewski last worked at the former Arnold Print Works in Adams for several years, until retiring when the mill ceased operations. Earlier, she had worked at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. in Adams and the former Sprague Electric Co. in North Adams.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. She was a member of the St. Stanislaus Rosary Sodality and the Polish Women's Alliance.

She enjoyed reading newspapers, knitting and crocheting, and sending letters and packages to Poland.

Her husband, Edwin M. Saharczewski, whom she married on November 23, 1940, died on December 1, 1991.
