Mr. Peter James Demastrie III, 58, of Savoy, died Friday morning, April 8, 2022 at Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston. He was born in North Adams on February 11, 1964, a son of the late Peter J. Demastrie, Jr. and Lillian M. (Whalen) Demastrie. He attended local schools, graduating from C.H. McCann Technical High School in 1982. He received his bachelor's degree from Purdue University, and earned his Master's degree in computer systems engineering from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. Pete worked as a senior advanced software engineer at General Dynamics in Pittsfield since 1998. Earlier, he had worked at the former Beloit Corp. in Dalton. He attended the First Baptist Church and enjoyed collecting clocks, watches and art. He is survived by his daughter, Nichole Demastrie of Savoy; his nephew, James Demastrie of Adams; his longtime partner, Nancy Ellsworth, with whom he resided; as well as several cousins.
