Mr. Peter I. Whitney, 73, of Cheshire, died Tuesday, March 10, 2020 at his home. He was born in Adams on April 13, 1946, a son of the late Charles and Fronie (Jones) Whitney. He attended schools in Cheshire, and graduated from Mt. Greylock Regional High School, Williamstown. Peter was a dairy farmer all of his life, and operated Whitney's Farm in Cheshire with his family for many years. He had served on the Town of Cheshire Zoning Board of Appeals for many years, and enjoyed deep sea fishing and spending time with his grandchildren.
