Mr. Peter Zabek, Jr., 82, of Windsor Pond, died on Saturday, September 17, 2022, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on April 7, 1940, a son of the late Peter and Mildred (Nowak) Zabek. He attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School in 1958.

He was a Veteran of the United States Air Force, serving from 1958 to 1962 with an honorable discharge.

Mr. Zabek last worked in the finance department of Ronnie's Cycle. Earlier he had been the Vice President and Treasurer of the former South Adams Savings Bank for 30 years.
