



## Phyllis B. Blazejewski

December 4, 1919 - March 2, 2012

Mrs. Phyllis Barbara (Dabrowski) Blazejewski, 92, formerly of 3 Myrtle St. Adams, died early Friday morning, March 2, 2012, at North Adams Regional Hospital.

She was born in Adams on December 4, 1919, a daughter of the late Joseph and Harriet (Ciejka) Dabrowski, and attended Adams schools.

Mrs. Blazejewski worked at the former Adams Super Market in Adams for many years, until her retirement. Earlier, she had worked at the former Sprague Electric Co. in North Adams.

She had been a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, where she was a member of its St. Cecelia's Choir. She was a member of the St. Stanislaus Rosary Sodality; Court Sancta Regina of the Catholic Daughters of the Americas, Adams; a member and Past Vice President of the Adams Senior Citizens; and a member of the Adams Golden Varsity.

She enjoyed walking, reading, traveling, playing cards and doing crossword puzzles. Her husband, Theodore F. Blazejewski, whom she married on May 10, 1941, died on October 12, 2003.
