



## Priscilla Gould

Mrs. Priscilla A. (Currier) Gould, 81, of 1 Berkshire Square, Adams, died Thursday evening at her home.

She was born in Newburyport, MA on June 2, 1923, a daughter of the late Rowland and Walborg (Bye) Currier, and attended Newburyport schools, graduating from Newburyport High School. She then graduated from the Somerville (MA) Hospital School of Nursing as a Registered Nurse.
