Mr. Raymond G. DiOrio, 88, of 160 Harryel St., Pittsfield, died on Sunday, May 6, 2012 at Springside Nursing Home, Pittsfield.

He was born in Schenectady, New York on January 1, 1924, son of the late Samuel and Carmela (Capasso) DiOrio. He attended schools in New York.

Mr. DiOrio was a veteran of World War II, having served with United States Navy until being honorably discharged on January 5, 1942.
