Mr. Francis Raymond Langer, 88, of 1 Berkshire Square, Adams, died Monday afternoon, November 15, 2010, at Williamstown Commons. He was born in Adams on November 2, 1922, son of the late Gustave and Mary (Porter) Langer. He attended Adams schools, and graduated from the former Adams High School with the Class of 1940.

He then enrolled in the Apprentice Course at General Electric Co. in Pittsfield, graduating in 1943. Mr. Langer then worked at General Electric Co. in Pittsfield, retiring as a senior designer in the drafting department in 1987. He had been a communicant of the Parish of Pope John Paul the Great, Adams, and had been a longtime communicant of the former St. Thomas Aquinas Church, Adams. He was a member of the General Electric Quarter Century and Pensioner's Clubs.

He is survived by his wife, the former Claire E. Fitzgerald, whom he married on October 12, 1950;
