



Raynor Linzey

October 17, 1933 - June 12, 2013

Mr. Raynor Linzey, 79, of 28 East Orchard Terrace, Adams, died on Wednesday, June 12, 2013 at the North Adams Regional Hospital.

He was born in Haines Falls, New York on October 17, 1933, son of the late George and Dorothy (Raynor) Linzey. He attended schools in New York and graduated from the Hunter Tannersville Central School. He then went on to graduate from Norwich University in Northfield, Vermont. While at Norwich he helped establish the Physics Department with his professor.

Mr. Linzey last worked as an engineer at Steinerfilm in Williamstown until retiring. Earlier he had worked for the former Sprague Electric Co., North Adams and Hughes Aircraft in California.

He was a communicant of the Parish of Blessed John Paul, Adams.

He is survived by his wife, the former Elizabeth A. O'Connor, whom he married on August 10, 1957;
