



Mr. Richard T. Dean

November 11, 1927 - December 14, 2016

Mr. Richard T. "Dick" Dean, 89, of Adams, died Wednesday evening, December 14, 2016, after a courageous battle with cancer.

He was born in North Adams on November 11, 1927, a son of the late Alfred and Aurette (Aubin) Dean, and attended North Adams schools.

Richard married the love of his life, the former Josephine B. Lesniak, on October 26, 1946 in St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. She preceded him to the Lord on February 14, 2009.

As a young man, he was a proud member of Company M of the Massachusetts National Guard, and he loved telling stories from when he served.

Richard retired from General Electric Co. in Pittsfield in 1992 after many years of dedicated service. When he was not spending time with his family, he loved to hunt at his deer camp in Vermont, bowling with his Tuesday Night League in Pittsfield, and golfing at Forest Park Country Club in Adams with the Wednesday and Sunday golf leagues. He was also a longtime member of the Adams Forest Wardens.
