Richard C. Mirke, 78, of 266 East Road, Clarksburg, died Friday, April 3, 2015 at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

He was born in North Adams on November 22, 1936, son of Richard and Agnes (Moreau) Mirke. He attended schools in North Adams.

Mr. Mirke was a Veteran of the Korean Conflict having served as a member of SAC in the United States Air Force. After his discharge he worked for R. T. Arnold Lumber Company, was a member of the local Carpenters Union working for several area contractors. For over 25 years he owned and operated a pavement marking business called Paint-A-Line. He also worked for the Town of Clarksburg as a laborer before retiring from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts DPW as a laborer.

Richard was a long time member of the Peter A. Cook Post #9144 of Clarksburg.

Surviving Richard are his wife of 53 years, the former Sharron A. Holland whom he married on September 30, 1961; their son Karl R. Mirke and his wife Joanne of Adams, his beloved grand-kitty Sebastian, many nieces, nephews, grand nieces and nephews and their children.

He was predeceased by his sisters Verna Petri and Marlene Tanner.
