Mr. Richard A. St. Germain, 73, of 136B North Summer St., Adams, died on Saturday morning, February 20, 2016 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield. He was born in Newport, New Hampshire on October 2, 1942, son of the late Aime and Blanche (Gagnon) St. Germain. He moved to Adams at a young age and attended schools there.

Mr. St. Germain worked as an inspector for the former General Electric Co., Pittsfield and its successor, General Dynamics until retiring in 1998.

He was a communicant of the Parish of St. John Paul II at St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams.
