Mrs. Rita (Menard) Bianchi, 93, of Adams, died on Tuesday, May 15, 2018 at the Mt. Greylock Extended Care Facility in Pittsfield.

She was born in Ludlow on August 20, 1924, a daughter of the late Felix and Josephine (LaFromboise) Menard. She attended schools in Ludlow and moved to Dalton and graduated from the former Dalton High School in 1942. Mrs. Bianchi worked for many years as a secretary at General Electric Co., Pittsfield until retiring in 1984.
