Robert H. Chalmers III, 46, of Adams, died Thursday morning, July 17, 2025 at his home, following a brief battle with pancreatic cancer. He was born in North Adams on May 22, 1979, the son of Robert H. Chalmers, Jr. and the late Diane M. (LeSage) Chalmers. He graduated from Hoosac Valley High School with the Class of 1997 and graduated from Utica College of Syracuse University in 2001 with his bachelor's degree. Bobby worked as the partnership and marketing manager for Racing Junk.com and, with his father, was co-owner and operator of Drive Shafts by DMC. He was also the founder and editor-in-chief of Race Pro Weekly, an online auto racing magazine with a nationwide following. Bobby's true passion was auto racing of all types. He was a member of the Eastern Motor Sports Press Association and the Mountain Club of Adams. and attended the Paish of St. John Paul II at Notre Dame des Sept Douleurs Church, Adams. He is survived by his father, Robert H. Chalmers, Jr.; his special friend, Meagen Nestle, and several aunts, uncles and cousins.
