Robert J. Fryc, 68, of 49 Summer St. Adams, died Tuesday, August 21, 2007 at his home.

He was born in Adams on October 8, 1938, a son of the late Bernard and Clara (Pytko) Fryc. He attended St. Stanislaus Elementary School and graduated from the former Adams High School in 1956. He received a certificate in accounting from St. Joseph's College in Bennington, VT in 1965. He had also completed several business classes at C.H. McCann Technical School's graduate program.
