Mr. Robert Arthur Groves, III, 85, of Dalton, formerly of Adams, died on Friday, February 16, 2018, at Hillcrest Commons in Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on December 5, 1932, son of the late Robert A. Groves, Jr. and Mary (Marlow) Groves Lescarbeau and his step father, James Lescarbeau. He attended schools in Adams.

Mr. Groves was a Veteran having served with the United States Navy for 30 years during the Korean and Vietnam Wars, and served on many ships, including the U.S.S. Yorktown. He retired honorably as a Senior Chief Petty Officer.

Mr. Groves last worked for as the Chief Power Plant Engineer for the NASA Ames Research Center in Mountain View, CA until his retirement. He had also worked as an engineer for many nuclear power plants along the West Coast.
