



Robert N. Kurley, Sr.

February 4, 1937 - October 21, 2009

Mr. Robert N. Kurley, Sr., 72, of 3 Myrtle St. Adams, died Wednesday evening, October 21st, at Williamstown Commons.

He was born in Adams on February 4, 1937, a son of the late Stanley and Olive (Bush) Kurley. He graduated from the former Adams High School, and also had attended the former North Adams State College.

Mr. Kurley worked as a chemical technician in the Naval Ordnance division of General Electric Co. in Pittsfield for 29 years, until retiring January 1, 1994. While there, he had worked on major projects including the Aegis Radar Director and Liquid Propellant Guns.
