Mr. Robert E. Ramocki, 68, of Bonita Springs, Florida, a native of Adams, died Tuesday, May 30, 2017, at his home.

He was born in Adams on March 14, 1949, a son of Anne (Brown) Ramocki Duval and the late Stanley Ramocki. He attended Adams schools, and graduated from the former Adams High School with the Class of 1967. He also attended Berkshire Community College and the University of Rhode Island.
