



## Robert Tremblay

Mr. Robert Donald Tremblay, 51, of 240 East Drive, Copiague, New York, a native of Adams, died Friday morning at Good Samaritan Hospital Medical Center in West Islip, New York, following a courageous battle with cancer. He was born in Adams on September 7, 1954, a son of Claire M. (Ouellette) Tremblay Kennedy and the late William J. Tremblay. He attended Adams schools and graduated from Hoosac valley High School in 1972. He attended Berkshire Community College in Pittsfield before moving to New York City in 1974, and then he later moved to Long Island.

Mr. Tremblay worked as a mortgage trader for DAIWA Corporation in New York.

While in Adams, he was a communicant of the Parish of Notre Dame and St. Thomas Aquinas.

Besides his mother, of Adams, he is survived by 2 sisters - E. Jean Loffler and Joan Cain, both of Williamstown, MA;

2 Brothers - William Tremblay of Beaufort, South Carolina, and Daniel Tremblay of Adams; and several nieces and nephews, as well as several close friends in New York City.
