



Mrs. Rolande "Rollie" Mahoney

June 3, 1930 - July 26, 2015

Mrs. Rolande M. "Rollie" (Remillard) Mahoney, 85, of 73 Bracewell Ave. North Adams, died Sunday morning, July 26, 2015, at her daughter's home in Florida, MA, surrounded by her family.

She was born in North Adams on June 3, 1930, a daughter of the late Romeo and Edna (Lecuyer) Remillard , and attended the former Notre Dame Elementary School in North Adams.
