Mrs. Roma Kathleen (Martin) Lanier, 89, of 4 Columbia St. Adams, died Tuesday evening at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

She was born in Adams on March 22, 1916, a daughter of the late Peter and Mary (Bachinske) Martin, and attended schools in Adams, including the former Hoosac St and Renfrew Elementary schools, and the former Adams High School.
