



## Ronald F. Lebeau

December 17, 1934 - January 4, 2012

Mr. Ronald Franklin LeBeau, 77, of 14 Meadow Lane, Adams, died on Wednesday, January 4, 2012 at his home.

He was born in Adams on December 17, 1934, the only child of the late Leo and Rachel (Gillette) LeBeau. He attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School with the class of 1953.
