



## Mrs. Rose T. Gancarz

Mrs. Rose Teresa (Pellizzari) Gancarz, 90, of 17 Pleasant St. Adams, a former longtime resident of Burlingame Hill, died early Thursday morning, October 30, 2014, at her home.
