Mrs. Ruth Mae (Brenner) Crawford, 82, of 167 North Summer St., Adams, died Sunday January 7, 2007, at Mercy Hospital in Springfield.

She was born in Adams on May 4, 1924, a daughter of the late Frank and Alice (Varno) Brenner. She attended schools in Adams, and graduated from the former Adams High School with the class of 1942. Mrs. Crawford then received her Bachelors of Science Degree from Syracuse University in 1945, and her Masters of Education from the former North Adams State College in 1974.

Mrs. Crawford was a Mathematics teacher for 35 years for the Adams School System and later for the Adams-Cheshire Regional School District, until retiring 20 years ago.
