Mrs. Sally Parkhill (Webster) Douglas, 71, of Naples, FL, formerly of Cheshire, died on Wednesday, August 23, 2023, at Physicians Regional Hospital in Naples.

She was born in Middlebury, VT on February 11, 1952, daughter of the late Harry and Marjorie (Parkhill) Webster. She earned her bachelor's in teaching and master's in education from the former North Adams State College.

Mrs. Douglas was the Assistant Superintendent of Business and Finance for the Pittsfield Public School System for 18 years, retiring in 2011.

She was a communicant of the Parish of St. John Paul II, Adams. She was the past president of the Massachusetts Association of School Business Officials, past president of the Berkshire County Red Cross, past board member and Board of Investment for the former South Adams Savings Bank, past board member for Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts and past finance chair for the Parish of St. John Paul II. She had also been a longtime member of the Taconic Golf Club in Williamstown.
