Mrs. Sandra L. (Stewart) Konieczny, 71, of 17 Cross St. Adams, died late Monday evening, August 3, 2015, at Williamstown Commons.

She was born in Pittsfield on August 17, 1943, a daughter of the late Kenneth and Pearl (Chamberlain) Stewart. She came to Adams at age 5 with her family, and graduated from the former Adams High School with the Class of 1962. She also attended the former North Adams State College.
