Mrs. Sharon V. (Lyons) Filiault, 59, of 28 Summer St. Adams, died early Thursday morning, November 21, 2013, at her home.

She was born in Adams on December 14, 1953, a daughter of Laurette C. (Levesque) Lyons and the late Thomas P. Lyons. She attended Adams schools, and graduated from Hoosac Valley High School with the Class of 1971.

Sharon had worked for Big Y Supermarkets and its predecessor, Adams Super Markets, for nearly 40 years, retiring due to ill health as head cashier at the Adams store in 2011.

She was a communicant of the Parish of Blessed John Paul, Adams. She enjoyed cooking, shopping, and spending time with her family.

Besides her mother, Laurette Lyons, of Adams, she is survived by her husband of 28 years, Jeffrey R. Filiault, whom she married on August 3, 1985; 2 Sons, Patrick Filiault of Adams, and Jeffrey Filiault of Jamaica Plain; 2 Daughters, Jennifer Nocher of Adams, and Alexandra Filiault of Readsboro, VT;
