



Sophie M. Dziegiel

October 13, 1918 - October 14, 2010

Mrs. Sophie M. (Sniezek) Dziegiel, 92, of 128 North Summer St. Adams, died early Thursday morning, October 14, 2010, at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

She was born in Adams on October 13, 1918, a daughter of the late Michael and Mary (Bednarz) Sniezek, and attended Adams schools.

Mrs. Dziegiel last worked in the Deli department at the former Adams Super Market for many years, until her retirement. Earlier, she had worked at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. and the former Adams Nursing Home. She had been a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. She was a member of the St. Stanislaus Rosary Sodality, the Adams Senior Citizens and the Adams Quilters. She enjoyed walking, traveling, reading and quilting.
