



## Sophie Salamon

August 19, 1918 - September 25, 2006

Mrs. Sophie (Adamczyk) Salamon, 88, of 39 Victory St. Adams, died Monday evening at North Adams Commons.

She was born in Adams on August 19, 1918, daughter of the late Ludwik and Mary (Nowicki) Adamczyk. She returned to Poland with her family as a child, and attended schools there, returning finally to Adams in December of 1937.

Mrs. Salamon last worked in the sewing department of the former Waverly Fabrics in Adams for 12 years, until retiring in 1982. Earlier, she had worked for several years at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. in Adams and the former Wall Streeter Shoe Co. in North Adams.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and a member of the former TMTM Club in Adams. She enjoyed sewing, baking, and especially her grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Her husband, Frank A. Salamon, whom she married on February 15, 1947, died on October 30, 1989.
